

How to Dye Parasital Opaque Colors

Materials List

- Big Pot, Stainless Steel or an Enamel Canning Pot
- Dish Detergent
- Bucket Optional
- 3+ gallons of Water
- Tablespoon
- Gloves,
- Large Slotted Spoon
- Dye

* Designate the Pot and utensils only for Dyeing, **Never** use them to cook food with.*



1. Add a small amount of dish detergent to a Bucket or the Sink and fill with hot water. Place parasital in the in the soapy water. Let it Soak.



2. Add 1 quart water to the pot, Add 1 Tablespoon Dye. Cook for 15 minutes.
3. Add the rest of the water to the pot and stir, stir, stir until the dye is completely dissolved.



4. Rinse the parisial.
5. Stir the Pot.
6. Add the Wet Parisial to the Dye Pot and Stir more. Keep stirring and Poking down the parisial every few minutes.
7. Let it cook 15 + minutes for Dark Colors and Less for Lighter Colors.
8. Remove Parisial from Dye Pot when desired color is obtained + A Shade or Two Darker. It will lighten up when it dries.



9. Rinse the dyed hat and dry thoroughly.
10. Proceed to Casso Fix instructions.

***To Dye Lighter Colors and Pastels use less dye ... 1 to 2 Teaspoons and do a test patch.**
